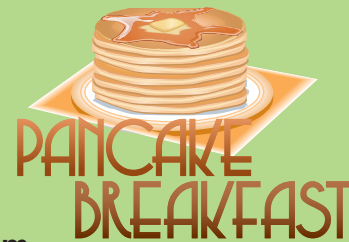

We are being blessed with very nice weather for the fall of 2011. This in no way compares to the spring of 2011. However, on the average we have to agree it has been a very good year.

The excessive moisture that we had in the spring certainly affected the sales for your Co-operative, because it affected the farming community where the crops did not get planted as were planned and also affected the oil industry as the road conditions and moisture conditions did not allow for planned explorations and development.

This year certainly indicates to us that things do not always go as planned, however, it also has indicated to us that when things do not follow a plan, new plans are developed and we make the best of the situation given to us. The Co-operative is going into another change over the next short while. We are beginning a move to consolidate more of the building related hardware items such as electrical, plumbing, paint, and tools to the Hill Ave location. We apologize for the past where these were located in two separated locations and hope that this change will increase the level of service that we can provide to you, our valued customer.

The change will begin occurring in the next several months and it is our hope that the majority of the hardware related products will be relocated prior to Christmas.

We have also enhanced the product offering at our Metro Center with the move of our Christmas toys and Christmas decorations and lights. We also anticipate moving more of the home décor and seasonal product lines to our Metro Center to enhance the service offering that we provide at the Metro Center. This year we want to celebrate Christmas on 3rd Street with all of the other business located on 3rd Street.
